



Brantôme... the Venice of the Périgord Vert

Romance, culture, rich history, boutiques, cafes, recreation.... the city of Brantôme offers it all. Situated on an island in the Périgord Vert (Dordogne), approximately one hour's drive from Aubeterre, is the "Venice of the Périgord". One of the main advantages of Brantôme is undoubtedly its natural setting amidst the rolling countryside of the Périgord Vert; nestled in between two branches of the river Dronne and protected by a huge cliff beneath which nestles the "Abbaye" of Brantôme. This beautiful monastery is definitely one of the finest in the region. Brantôme is a city to explore on foot and the old town has a mix of influences from the Middle Ages and the Renaissance and is full of historic buildings. One of the best views is from the bridge over the river Dronne, which during the summer season is favourite for a trip by canoe. The bridge leads to the "Jardin des Moines", a park where you can relax in summer. A good time to visit Brantôme is during the market on Friday morning. The city then comes to life and gives you the chance to further explore the regional riches of the Périgord.
