The medieval city of "Sarlat" is situated in the Périgord Noir (Dordogne) approximately 2.5 hours drive from Aubeterre, and is truly one of the most spectacular cities in France. An "open air museum" of architecture from the Medieval, Renaissance and 17th century periods, it is a festival of porches, turrets, arches and arcades. This charming Périgordine town is so well preserved that you might well believe yourself back in the Middle Ages. It is therefore not surprising that this historic pearl has formed the backdrop for many "medieval" films. Through the careful preservation of its historic buildings and romantic atmosphere, Sarlat is today a favourite tourist attraction offering plenty of boutiques, and famous for its "foie gras" and truffles.
